Below are discussion points to help aid group conversation about J.John's teaching on Faith, Hope and Love.

HOPE

Discussion

- What does it mean to let our 'hopes' rather than our 'hurts' shape our future?
- J.John talks about how despair distorts our perspective. Thinking practically, what does it look like to move from despair into hope, bearing in mind the complex and deep-rooted issues that many of us face in life?
- Read the Emmaus Road story in Luke 24:13-35. Is there anything that stands out to you?
- Hope is described in the Bible as the 'anchor of our soul'. What does this imagery mean to you?
- What does it mean to have a 'living' hope in Jesus?

Practical Application

- J.John describes when John Wesley's heart was 'strangely warmed'. Have you experienced something like this? Do you need to make a decision to commit or recommit your life to Jesus? If you aren't yet ready to make that decision, do you need to make a decision to continue exploring Christianity?
- Is there an area of your life where despair is becoming too much? Do you need to rediscover the living hope we find in Jesus?
