Below are discussion points to help aid group conversation about J.John's teaching on Faith, Hope and Love.

LOVE

Discussion

- What does it mean to clothe ourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience?
- Thinking back to J.John's story about the cashier in the supermarket, can you think of any examples where compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience could have made a real difference to someone's day?
- Sometimes it is difficult to see how friends and family might turn to God, particularly if they seem very far from him. In this instance it might be easy to give up on someone and think that they are beyond hope. J.John reminded us that God never gives up on anyone and neither should we. What does not giving up on someone look like practically?
- How do we show love to others when we don't feel it reciprocated?
- What does it mean to become people of faith, hope and love, and how do we transmit that to others?

Practical Application

- God's love for us meant that he forgave us. As a response, we should forgive others. Is there anyone you need to forgive today?
- Thinking deeply about the challenge of this message, how do you personally treat those for whom Jesus died? The poor, the outcast, the sick. Is there something you need to do to live simply so that someone else can simply live?
